 - b. Demonstrate effective implementation of culturally-sensitive assessments.
- 5. Identify and discuss common health disparities faced by the Hispanic population.
 - a. Discuss issues related to care access, equity, affordability, and social justice in the care of Hispanic patients.
 - b. Advocate for the provision of culturally-competent healthcare that meets the needs of the Hispanic patient.
