Students are expected to post in the discussion board a **minimum** of **three separate posts** and three separate post dates per discussion thread. The three posts for **each** thread must include:

- 1. One "initial" post in response to the instructor's question (or stated assignment) no later than Thursday of each course week.
- 2. Two "follow up" post in response to at least one classmate by Sunday of each course week.

The initial response to a discussion question should substantively demonstrate familiarity with the content of the question. The response should be 150-200 words in length. To ensure the discussion is a collective and focused exploration of the topic in the question, the discussion thread should remain focused on the question.

The timing of responses is important since other students are dependent on your postings in order to fully develop the discussion and to post "follow up" discussion entries. Responses should occur in the week the discussion question is posted for reply. Preparation for the response is encouraged to ensure a thoughtful and well-founded contribution to the discussion.

Each learner is expected to both respond initially (by Thursday each week) to the discussion question or assignment instruction posted by the instructor/facilitator each week and make at least two follow-up responses to other learners' postings in the discussion thread by the end of the week (Sunday at 11:59pm). The purpose is to ensure an informed and thoughtful dialogue focused on the topic.

There are no evaluations in this course (e.g. pre-test or post-test). The Health Care Project is the capstone work for the program and should be considered evidence of learning much as a final examination would typically demonstrate.

Your final submission for this course will be a paper that is 10-15 pages in length. Working with your professor, you will define a complex problem in a contrived organization and conduct an analysis of the problem with recommendations to management for action. The problem is related to the topic you select. The project should reflect selected key principles from throughout all courses in the program. The project should be organized and supported through research and critical thinking.

Final Paper

Central Christian Health Care (CCHC) is a large national health system used as the contrived environment for the topic and case exploration. There are a number of subsidiaries and networks comprising various divisions and operations within CCHC. You

are serving on a consulting team recently engaged by CCHC to review several cases occurring within organizations related to CCHC. Some of the organizations and cases occur within the CCHC system and some are occurring in organizations CCHC is considering acquiring or affiliation with in some form.

The project will result in a set of recommendations made to a "management team" regarding an approach to the selected topic. Ethical, leadership and technology based elements should be present in the project, although two of these three are sufficient in a well-developed project to demonstrate the application of the key principles discussed in the course.

The project must be substantive enough to allow sufficient demonstration and exploration of program outcomes and should be focused enough to bring a practical and applicable conclusion to the project. The project should provide the opportunity to apply previous work through reflection, research and review. A contrived organization (Central Christian Health Care) is used to organize the project. The purpose of the project is to create a framework for exploration of several key program components and demonstrate an analytical model sufficiently to recommend real world solutions and recommendations for organizational response to the topic.
