Students may keep response journals, write short essays on a variety of topical subjects and study models of good writing. Emphasis is placed on student centered and writing-to-learn activities as well as collaborative and cooperative learning techniques. Lecture is also used at times. Teaching aids include power point presentations, videos, supplemental reading materials, and audio-files. Guest speakers may also be used to enhance student learning.
