## **Course Description**

3 Credits

Prerequisites: NONE

This course will give students an overview of the current US healthcare delivery system and its associated costs. It will enable students to accurately define insurance terms and abbreviations and introduces students to the functions and procedures of health insurance programs. The course will familiarize students with requirements, rules, regulations and laws pertaining to various insurance programs.

#### **Course Outcomes**

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Indicate and describe the historical milestones of the US health care system and describe their impact.
- Describe the impact of recent health care reform, including the ACA.
- Distinguish between the major stakeholders of the US health care system.
- Use statistics to compare the US health care system with those of other countries.
- Summarize key government and public health programs that have played a role in US health care and explain their impact.
- Identify and distinguish between the various hospital classifications, including the inpatient and outpatient services provided.
- Classify the types of physicians and professionals working in the US health care industry and distinguish between their roles.
- Identify and distinguish between various types of insurance programs and health care funding, including private health insurance plans and government programs, such as Medicare and Medicaid.
- Identify and describe current US health care trends.

Discussion	Part 1: Identify an article in the mainstream media that address topics that have an impact on the cost of health care in the US. You will need to review newspapers, magazines and/or search online databases of articles and identify an article that addresses topic(s) with an impact on healthcare costs. The newspapers, magazines or databases used must be produced by mainstream media outlets, such as: Reuters, the Associated Press, The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, the Washington Post, Time Magazine, Newsweek, The Economist, Crain's, National Public Radio (NPR), CNN, or CNBC. Do NOT use articles or information from blogs, tabloids or un-edited sources.  Attach a link to the article in your response.  Part 2: Discussion of the Issues. You will need to write a discussion of the topic of the article and its impact on cost of care. You should strive to discuss a cost impact that is real and supportable by research. Don't speculate unless you can support your thoughts or ideas with available research data (in which case you should discuss this data in your response). Your discussion must address ALL of the following questions: What is the cost that is implicated by the article? What is the measurable impact over time? Who is affected by the issue?
Assignments	The four parts to Medicare: List the four parts of Medicare and define them in your own words. Why is each of the four parts important to an enrollee?  Your response should be at least 300 words. Please cite any references using APA format.
